# Meditate on the Scripture

Today's Scripture Reading:

*Isaiah 54:13*  
*Mark 11*

The Holy Spirit wants me to remind you this morning that NO WEAPON THAT IS FORMED AGAINST YOU SHALL PROSPER (Isaiah 54:13) You have got to get that scripture off the pages and into your heart. The enemy has launched an all out attack against you because he knows that your miracle, breakthrough, and blessing are at hand. Not around the corner, but, at hand. You must meditate on the scripture.

Come on and get it into your spirit. Say - "no weapon that is formed against me shall prosper." Now get it out of your mouth and into your head. "No weapon that is formed against me shall prosper." Now, get it from your head into your heart. Come on - No weapon that is formed against me shall prosper."

Now you have reminded yourself of what God has said. Next, we need to remind The Lord of what He has said. The Bible says that we are to put God in remembrance of His word. Think in terms of your own children. Often you promise them that they can do something or have something. However, when it comes time to do it or to get it you have a different answer. Your children trust you to keep your word so they cannot believe you have lied to them, so they assume you have forgotten. Consequently, they remind you of what you have previously said to them.

Each of us have been here - "mama/daddy remember that you said?" Not that God ever forgets - but, He said it is alright for us to put Him in remembrance of His word. Lets do it! Lord, You promised me in Your word that no weapon that is formed against me shall prosper. I believe Your word and I stand on Your word. This weapon that has been formed against me shall not prosper. I claim victory over it. I declare it, I decree it, and I have it. In the wonderful name of Jesus - because He promised me that if I said it, then I would have it (Mark 11).

The final thing we need to do to meditate on and to get this scripture to become effective in our lives is to remind the devil of what God has promised. You might say why remind the devil? It is because the devil has a short memory. He is banking on us not knowing God's word, and reminding him of what God has said renders him ineffective. You remember when Jesus was in the

wilderness and the devil came to him with weapons? Jesus defeated the devil by reminding the devil of what God had said. Jesus is our example isn't he?

Now, I know that some of you super religious folks have a hard time talking to the devil. But, you talk to the devil each time you do something wrong because he suggested that you do it and you respond to him with a yes. It is alright. Let's talk to him together. Devil, God promised me that no weapon you formed against me will prosper. In case you do not know what that means let me explain. I will not give up, because no weapon that is formed against me shall prosper. I will not turn around, because Jesus promised me in Galatians 6:9 that I will be successful if I just keep on doing good. I will not doubt. I will not loose my house, my car nor my job because I am a tither and God promised me in Malachi 3:10 to kill anything and anybody that were trying to kill me. I will not die because by His stripes I am healed (Isaiah 54). My children will not fail because God promised me in Isaiah 54:13 that they will have peace. Devil, you are a lie. **NO WEAPON THAT IS FORMED AGAINST ME SHALL PROSPER.**

Now, encourage yourself. Say this with me - I have come too far to turn around now. I have given up too much to turn around now. I cannot give up. I am not a quitter. I will win. I will prosper. I will have it. I can do it. It is mine. It belongs to me. It has my name on it. What God has for me - ain't nobody going to get it but me. Now give our God some praise. Bless His Holy name for giving a right now word.
